The Early Christian ditch



In aois na luath-Chríostaíochta (450AD) athraíodh carn mór Chnómha i láithreán ollmhór cosanta. Tochlaíodh dhá dhíog ollmhóra, ceann ag bun an chairn agus an ceann eile gar don bharr. Is cosúil go raibh taoiseach ag cosaint a chuid limistéir, agus go raibh rudaí trína chéile faoin am sin. Lean an láithreán ar aghaidh mar ionad cosanta díreach tríd an Mheánaois.

In the early Christian era (450AD) the great mound of Knowth was transformed into a massive defended site. Two huge ditches were dug, one at the base of the mound, the other near the top. It seems likely that a powerful chieftain was defending his territory and that times were turbulent. The site continued in use as a defended location right through to the Middle Ages.
